ELIGIBILITY:

- I) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the three year integrated course leading to the Bachelor of Commerce must have passed Std. XII Examination conducted by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education with the following subjects:
- 1) English
- (2) Any one of the Modern Indian Languages or Modern Foreign Languages or any classical language or information technology.
- 3) Any three subjects from among the subjects mentioned below: (i) Economics (ii) Book-Keeping and Accountancy (iii) Organisation of Commerce (iv) Co-operation (v) Geography
- 4) Any one optional subject carrying 100 marks from Mathematics & Statistics / CSP II) Those who have passed an examination of another University/Board or Body recognised as equivalent thereto.

<u>DURATION OF THE COURSE</u>: Duration of the course shall be six semesters spread over 3 years.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION:

- F.Y./S.Y./T.Y. B.Com. Students should bring the following documents in original along with duly attested photocopies for verification at the time of admission:-
- i) Original mark sheet of H.S.C. and Leaving Certificate along with 2 photo copies for F.Y. admission.
- ii) Original Mark sheet of First year along with 2 photo copies for S.Y. admission.
- iii) Original Mark sheet of First year and second year along with 2 photo copies for T.Y. admission.
- iv) For new admission to S.Y./T.Y. (i.e. students from other colleges) —N.O.C. with enrolment details to be produced from the previous college.
- v) 2 recent passport size photographs for all classes.
- vi) Address Proof (Photocopy of Ration Card/ Electricity Bill/Telephone Bill/ Passport/ Driving License)any one.
- vii) Caste Certificate (If applicable)
- viii) Physically challenged candidates should produce the relevant certificate from competent authority.
- ix) FY Class students MUST fill up the Pre admission online Registration FORM of UNIVERSITY of MUMBAI before the due date, that shall be announced by the University

through the circular in due course of time. Last date of accepting the enrolment forms by college office will be decided by University of Mumbai. Students who fail to fill up the Online Registration & submission will not be admitted.
