ELIGIBILITY: (For B.M.S. / B.C.B.I. / B.A.F.)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the B.M.S./B.C.B.I./B.A.F. Degree Course shall have passed XIIth Std. Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination & secured not less than 45% marks in Aggregate (40% in case of Reserved Category) at one and the same sitting. or Diploma in any Engineering branches with two years or three years or four years duration after S.S.C. conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Maharashtra State or its equivalent examination. To be eligible for admission to the Degree Course in B.M.S./B.C.B.I./B.AF. a candidate shall have passed the H.S.C. Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent and secured not less than 45% marks on the aggregate (40% for backward), at the first attempt .

DURATION OF THE COURSE:

Duration of the Course shall be six semester spread over 3 years.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION:

- I) Original Mark Sheet of H.S.C. & Leaving Certificate along with two photo copies for F.Y. admission.
- ii) Original Mark sheet of Semester I & II along with 2 photo copies for S.Y. admission.
- iii) Original Mark sheet of Semester I, II, III & IV along with 2 photo copies for T.Y. admission.
- iv) For new admission to S.Y./T.Y.- NOC with enrolment details to be produced from the previous college.
- v) Two recent passport size photographs for all classes.
- vi) Address Proof (Photo copy of Ration Card/ Electricity Bill/Telephone Bill/ Passport/ Driving License) any one.
- vii) Caste Certificates (if applicable)
- viii) Eligibility Certificate (issued by University) for students coming from other than Maharashtra Board and Maharashtra Technical Board)
- ix) Physically challenged candidates should produce the relevant certificate from competent authority.

Note:- In case the original mark sheet of H.S.C. has been submitted for admission to any college, certificate to that effect, signed by the Principal of that college must be produced.

The learners shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate to qualify each course where the course consists of Internal Assessment & Semester End Examination. However, the learners shall obtain minimum of

40% marks i.e. 10 out of 25 in the Internal Assessment & 30 out of 75 in Semester End Examination separately.

To qualify each course minimum grade 'D' should be obtained by the learners in each course & project wherever applicable in a particular semester.
